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HEALTH HAZARD INFORMATION

Comite is classified as hazardous according to the criteria of the National Occupational Health and Safety Commission.

Harmful (Xn): (Propargite) R22 Harmful if swallowed

R36 Irritating to eyes

(Exxsol) R65 Harmful: May cause lung damage if swallowed

HEALTH EFFECTS:

ACUTE

Swallowed: May result in nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, abdominal pain and increased

salivation. Severe poisoning may result in mental confusion, convulsions

and unconsciousness.

Acute oral LD₅₀ = 2200 mg/kg (rat)

Eye: Contact with eyes may cause irritation.

Skin: Contact with skin will result in irritation. Repeat contact with skin can result

in allergic contact dermatitis. Propargite can be absorbed through the skin

with toxic effects.

Acute dermal $LD_{50} > 3400 \text{ mg/kg (rabbit)}$

Oral doses of this compound have been shown to cause depression, labored breathing, ataxia and diarrhea. Similar symptoms may occur through skin

absorption.

Inhaled: Vapor may be an irritant to the mucous membranes and respiratory tract.

CHRONIC

Skin: Formulation is a skin sensitizer (guinea pig).

Toxicology: Studies in animals have shown that propargite does not produce mutagenic.

No teratogenic effects were produced in pregnant rats, however in rabbits the NOEL (No Observable Effect Level) for teratogenicity is 10 mg/kg/day. Tests in rats have shown propagite to be an experimental animal carcinogen when indicated Maximum Tolerated Dose is exceeded. Therefore, propargite

is a possible human carcinogen.

FIRST AID:

If poisoning occurs, contact a doctor or Poisons Information Centre. Phone Australia 131 126.

Swallowed: Rinse mouth with water. If patient is conscious, give plenty of water to

drink. Where more than 15 minutes from a hospital, induce vomiting either

using fingers in the throat or with Ipecac Syrup APF.

Eye: Hold eye(s) open and flush with water for at least 15 minutes. Seek medical

advice.

Skin: Wash thoroughly with soap and water. Remove contaminated clothing and

launder before re-use. Propargite may be absorbed through the skin with a

resultant toxic effect.

Inhaled: Remove patient to fresh air. Remove contaminated clothing and loosen

remaining clothing. Keep patient warm, relaxed and comfortable until fully

recovered. If effects persist, seek medical advice.

FIRST AID FACILITIES:

Eye wash station.

ADVICE TO DOCTOR:

Treat symptomatically.



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PRECAUTIONS FOR USE

EXPOSURE STANDARDS:

None allocated for this material by the National Occupational Health and Safety Commission (Work safe Australia).

ENGINEERING STANDARDS:

Avoid breathing spray mist. Use only in a well ventilated area. Keep containers closed when not in use.

PERSONAL PROTECTION:

Avoid contact with eyes and skin. Do not inhale vapor or spray mist. Do not eat, drink or smoke while using. Wear cotton overalls buttoned to the neck and wrist, a washable hat, elbow-length PVC gloves, a face shield and disposable facemask. In the absence of adequate ventilation, use a respirator fitted with an agricultural chemical cartridge(s). If product on skin, immediately wash area with soap and water. After use and before eating, drinking, smoking or using the toilet, wash hands, arms and face thoroughly with soap and water. Launder contaminated clothing and protective equipment before storing or re-using.

FLAMMABILITY:

Combustible liquid. Use in well-ventilated area away from heat and naked lights.

STORAGE AND TRANSPORT:

Correct Shipping Name: UN No. 3082. ENVIRONMENTALLY HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCES, LIQUID, N.O.S (CONTAINS PROPARGITE) MARINE POLLUTANT.

Packaging Group: III

Classified as a 9 (MISCELLANEOUS) Dangerous Substance by the Australian Code for the Transport of Dangerous Goods by Road or Rail. Refer to relevant regulations for storage and transport requirements. This material is a Scheduled Poison (S6) and must be stored, maintained and used according to the relevant regulations.

Store in original container, away from children, animals, food and feedstuffs. Storage must be secure, and locks and/or seals in order, so contents cannot be tampered with. Check regularly for leaks. Keep cool and dry and out of direct sunlight or other sources of heat and ignition.

SPILLS:

Wear protective equipment to prevent skin and eye contamination as well as inhalation of vapors. Contain using sand or soil. Do not contaminate watercourses or drains with products or containers. Use absorbent (soil, sand, vermiculite or other inert materials). Transfer into secure, sealed and properly labeled containers for disposal. Do not reuse 200 L container for any purpose. If there is contamination of crops or waterways, advise emergency services or State Department of Agriculture.

DISPOSAL:

If recycling, replace cap and return clean containers to recycler or designated collection point. If not recycling, break, crush or puncture and bury empty containers in a local authority landfill. If not available, bury the containers below 500 mm in a disposal pit specifically marked and set up for this purpose clear of waterways, vegetation and roots. Empty containers and product should not be burnt. The minibulk container (1000 L) is reusable and remains the property of IAMA Limited. No other liquid, solid or pesticide product should be put into it. When empty, return to IAMA Limited for cleaning, relabelling and refilling.

For the bulk road tanker, empty contents fully into application equipment. Ensure all valves are closed prior to refilling or returning to point of supply for refill or storage.
